Based on the evaluation procedure – selection of Applicants at Zagreb University of Applied Sciences done by TVZ Erasmus Committee, TVZ is making the following

DECISION

On granting financial support from the Erasmus + program project No. 2020-1-HR01-KA107-077227 to one incoming and one outgoing mobilities for teaching. The grants are awarded to:

- 1. Petar Jandrić, employee of Zagreb University of Applied Sciences
- 2. Paul Prinsloo, employee of University of South Africa

Each applicant will be granted financial support according to the rules and regulations of ERASMUS+ Project 2020-1-HR01-KA107-077227. Petar Jandrić will realize the mobility at University of South Africa according to approved Staff mobility agreement, while Paul Prinsloo will realize mobility at Zagreb University of Applied Sciences according to approved Staff mobility agreement. For the outgoing mobility, financial support will be granted in the amount of 180 Euros per day for the first 14 days, 126 Euros per day from the 15th day and the additional travel costs in the amount of 1500 Euros. For the incoming mobility, financial support will be granted in the amount of 140 Euros per day for the first 14 days, 98 Euros per day from the 15th day and the additional travel costs in the amount of 1500 Euros. Financial support will be payed in Croatian Kuna if the payment occurs before January 1st 2023, while payments occurring after January 1st 2023 will be made in Euros.

The mutual rights and obligations, as well as the final amount of financial support will be defined in a separate Erasmus + agreement that will be signed between the applicants and Zagreb University of Applied Sciences.

The applicants may file a written complaint against the Decision within 8 working days from the date of receiving this Decision.
