Based on the evaluation procedure – selection of Applicants at Zagreb University of Applied Sciences done by TVZ Erasmus Committee, TVZ is making the following

DECISION

On granting financial support from the Erasmus + program project No.
2024-1-HR01-KA171-HED-000222332 **to** one incoming mobility and one outgoing mobility
for teaching. The grant awarded to:

1. Mia Čarapina, employee of Zagreb University of Applied Sciences
2. Lung Hsiang Wong, employee of Nanyang Technological University (Centre for Research in Pedagogy and Practice)

The applicant will be granted financial support according to the rules and regulations of ERASMUS+ 2024-1-HR01-KA171-HED-000222332. Mia Čarapina will realize mobility at Nanyang Technological University (Centre for Research in Pedagogy and Practice) and Lung Hsiang Wong will realize the mobility at Zagreb University of Applied Sciences, according to approved Staff mobility agreement. For the outgoing mobility financial support will be granted in the amount of 190 Euros per day for the first 14 days, 133 Euros per day from the 15th day and the additional travel costs in the amount of 1735 Euros. For the incoming mobility, financial support will be granted in the amount of 148 Euros per day for the first 14 days, 104 Euros per day from the 15th day and the additional travel costs in the amount of 1735 Euros. Financial support will be paid in Euros.

The mutual rights and obligations, as well as the final amount of financial support will be defined in a separate Erasmus + agreement that will be signed between the applicants and Zagreb University of Applied Sciences.

The applicants may file a written complaint against the Decision within 8 working days from the date of receiving this Decision.
